2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Title Page</u> - Your Name, Presentation Date, Name of Tribe, Region Name</li> </ul>		- Not required here. -
6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Climate &amp; Landforms</u> – Describe the climate and land in your region.</li> </ul>		
6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Neighboring Tribes</u> – How did your tribe interact with the neighboring tribes and what were some of the tribal names?</li> </ul>		
6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Description of Housing, Transportation, and Tools</u> – How did the people of your tribe get around and what were their homes like (include natural resources and tools used)?</li> </ul>		
6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Traditional Foods</u> – What were some of the foods eaten and what tools were necessary to get those foods and prepare them?</li> </ul>		
6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Traditional Clothing</u> – What was worn on a daily basis and what was worn for special occasions? How did people get this clothing?</li> </ul>		
6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Customs &amp; Culture</u> – What were some customs practiced (can include traditional games) and what made the culture of this tribe original?</li> </ul>		
6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Beliefs &amp; Traditional Story</u> – What is a belief that people of your tribe held and what is a traditional story? (In your PowerPoint only include key points, but be prepared to read the story to the class.)</li> </ul>		
6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Current Events</u> – What is your tribe like now? Where do the people live and what is a current event involving your tribe? If there are no longer any living members of the tribe or if the tribe no longer lives where they used to explain why that is.</li> </ul>
